State Tribal Investment Initiative Phase RFP (1 of 2)

This RFP supports tribal-led economic development through funding for planning, predevelopment, and implementation projects that support a resilient economy.

Up to \$15M in funding is available:

- Individual project can apply for \$500,000 up to \$1 million.
- Coalition projects may apply for \$500,000 up to \$2 million.

There will be two review periods:

- Round 1 Full Application Due: April 30, 2025
- Round 2 Full Application Due: March 13, 2026

Potential applicants are strongly encouraged to notify GO-Biz of their intent to apply by emailing regionalinvestment@gobiz.ca.gov by 5:00pm on March 26, 2025 (round one) or February 13, 2026 (round two). **Applicants that do not provide this notification may still apply.**
